The Accrediting Council on Education in Journalism and Mass Communications met April 29 and voted 12-3, with one abstention and one recusal, that the undergraduate program in the W. Page Pitt School of Journalism and Mass Communications receive reaccreditation. Sandy York, interim director, attended the meeting.

The Council expressed concerns about the noncompliances on Standard 1 (Mission, Governance and Administration) and Standard 7 (Resources, Facilities and Equipment), but concurred with the site team and Committee recommendations for reaccreditation. The next site team will pay particular attention to improvements on those standards.

We will be in touch with the director about the next visit for the school, scheduled for the 2027-28 academic year.
