The Accrediting Council on Education in Journalism and Mass Communications met April 28-29 in Chicago and voted 21-0, with three members abstaining, that the undergraduate program in the College of Journalism and Mass Communications at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln receive reaccreditation. Maria Marron, dean of the College of Journalism and Mass Communications, and Frauke Hachtmann, associate dean of the College of Journalism and Mass Communications, attended the meeting.
