The Accrediting Council on Education in Journalism and Mass Communications met April 28 in Chicago and voted 20-0 that the undergraduate program at the Manship School of Mass Communication at Louisiana State University receive reaccreditation, and voted 20-0 that the professional master's program receive reaccreditation. Josh Grimm, interim dean, attended the meeting.

The Council discussed the noncompliance on Standard 3 (Assessment of Learning Outcomes) in the master's program, but concurred with the site team and Committee recommendations for reaccreditation. The next site team will pay particular attention to improvements on Standard 3.
